CDC SYMPOSIUM AND SG50 BOOK CELEBRATE COMMUNITIES BUILT IN SHAPING A COHESIVE AND SELF-RELIANT SOCIETY

Against the backdrop of SG50 celebratory theme, "*CDCs Celebrating Communities*", close to 400 community and corporate partners, volunteers, grassroots leaders and CDC staff from five districts will come together on **Tuesday**, **27 October 2015** at Ci Yuan Community Club to take part in a CDC Symposium graced by Emeritus Senior Minister (ESM) Goh Chok Tong, who mooted the idea of the establishment of Community Development Councils (CDCs) back in 1997 to build a tightly-knit, compassionate and self-reliant community. The CDC Symposium serves as an important avenue for key stakeholders to celebrate the communities built over the years; understand the CDCs' mission and explore new areas CDCs and their partners can serve the communities. ESM Goh will deliver his keynote address at the CDC Symposium. A media Briefing, chaired by the five Mayors, will be held at **12.00noon before the commencement of the CDC Symposium**.

With the same SG50 celebratory theme, the first-ever publication by the five CDCs in the form of a story book, that chronicles 50 short stories by our local communities on the core values of the CDCs will also be launched at the event. The profiles and programmes featured in the *SG50 CDC Book* represent the communities that CDCs have built and developed over 18 years. The communities form the social fabric of Singapore and some of the values our founding fathers steered Singaporeans to embrace. Five values are encapsulated in the Book which comprise *More Able helping Less Able; Promoting Volunteerism; Promoting Community Ownership; Care for Environment; and Care for Vulnerable.*

3 The CDC SG50 Book importantly outlines how CDCs in our ABC mission - Assist the Needy; Bond the People; Connect the Community - work closely with the corporate and community partners to empower the community to do things for themselves and to help the less fortunate. The Book also reflects the spirit of ownership and volunteerism as 58 students from various schools in each of the five districts hone their writing skills and wrote these short real-life stories from various perspectives of the CDCs' stakeholders such as partners, corporate sponsors, volunteers and beneficiaries of CDCs' programmes/schemes.
