FIVE CDCs TO HOLD SKILLSFUTURE @ CDC 2020 'THE FUTURE OF YOU' TO SUPPORT LOCAL COMMUNITY AND BUSINESSES IN LIFELONG LEARNING, RESKILL AND UPSKILL

- From today, Singaporeans can sign up, at no cost, for the week-long event's more than 50 virtual learning activities and SkillsFuture Advice (SFA) workshops presented by more than 18 training providers, Institutes of Higher learning (IHLs), industry partners and celebrities.
- Participants will be able to access services like career coaching, a one stop site where job-seekers and working adults can pick up useful tips, new skills to maximise employability and access to the various job search platforms with over 10,000 job vacancies.

The five Community Development Council (CDCs) today announced that they will be, for the first time, jointly organising the **SkillsFuture@CDC 2020 – The Future of You**. This complements the Government's efforts to support the local community and Singapore businesses in lifelong learning, reskilling and upskilling. The event, which will kickstart from 10 August 2020, is made up of virtual exciting learning activities and edutainment programmes interjected by more than 50 workshops, masterclasses and inspirational series, and career advice for participants.

Details of the week-long event was elaborated at a virtual media conference hosted by Ms Low Yen Ling, Minister of State for Trade & Industry and Culture, Community and Youth, Chairman of Mayors' Committee and Mayor of South West District, together with Ms Denise Phua, Mayor of Central Singapore District, Mr Desmond Choo, Mayor of North East District, Mr Alex Yam, Mayor of North West District. The Chief Executive of SkillsFuture Singapore, Mr Ong Tze Ch'in, and Chief Executive of Employment and Employability Institute (e2i), Mr Gilbert Tan and celebrities were also present.

From soft skills, lifeskills, to technical skills such as job interview know-hows and video-editing, participants will have a comprehensive range of workshops to choose from. - To gain a better understanding of the current jobs and skills trends in the NEW NORMAL labour market, participants can take part in the SFA Workshops. Available in the four official languages across the week, the SFA Workshops will also guide participants to identify their interests, develop their plan to improve personal skills, and educate them on how to use MySkillsFuture portal to broaden their field of opportunities for career planning.
- Participants will also be able to sign up for free talks by industry professionals to help them navigate their career journey. Experts across various industries, from education to healthcare to digital marketing and information and communications technology, have been invited to share their experience and render valuable insights to participants. The virtual event will also have an inspiration series to motivate participants and help build confidence during these challenging times.



A. ABOUT SKILLSFUTURE@CDC 2020 - THE FUTURE OF YOU

- The five Community Development Councils (CDCs) jointly organised this year's **SkillsFuture** @ **CDC 2020 The Future of You** from **10 to 16 August 2020.**
- Themed "The Future of You", SkillsFuture @ CDC 2020 aims to connect with the community and encourage upskilling and reskilling as a means to future-proof each individual. As such, it is imperative for us to remain relevant and steadfast as we move forward into the future.
- SkillsFuture @ CDC 2020 is part of the SkillsFuture Month 2020 which involves over 18 community, education and industry partners and expected to reach out to 20,000 learners in Singapore.
- SkillsFuture @ CDC 2020 comprises learning activities for participants through a series of virtual and edutainment programmes, covering employability skills and lifelong learning topics. The event also brings together local celebrities to impart their know-hows and also take part in a journey learning and equipping themselves with new skills.
- The event is targeted at the general public, including fresh graduates, job seekers, mid-careerists, who may be looking to build skill sets for personal or professional development, or re-integrate back into the workforce.

1. Virtual Workshops

- There will be over 50 virtual learning activities of topics ranging from employability, lifestyle to in-demand tech skills and SkillsFuture Advice (SFA) workshops conducted by training providers, Institutes of Higher Learning and industry partners.
- The event also offers services like career coaching and a one stop site where job-seekers and working adults can pick up useful tips, new skills to maximise employability and access various job search platforms with over 10,000 job vacancies.
- SkillsFuture Advice Workshop a collaboration between SkillsFuture Singapore, CDCs, Workforce Singapore (WSG) and Employment and Employability Institute (e2i), the SFA Workshop is a community outreach initiative to raise awareness on SkillsFuture initiatives amongst Singaporeans and to encourage everyone to adopt a lifelong learning mind-set. The webinar focuses on guiding participants to develop resilience and upskilling plans through practical information and online resources. The workshops will be conducted in four languages throughout the week.
